Wisdom Teeth and Amida's Compassion



I was finally able to go to see a specialist and he pulled two wisdom teeth out this month. Although the operation was over, I was in continuous pain for a while afterward. I knew that it was just a matter of time for the recovery, but being unable to eat, I couldn't help but worry. Lying in bed, not having any will left, I began to think, "I wonder how long this pain is going to last."

That was when I noticed the calendar by the Shinshu Federation hanging on the wall in my room. There was a quote by Rev. Ryoshin Soga that read, "The suffering one experiences, is the encouragement we receive from Amida." I read this quote over and over again. For the first time in my life, I had experienced the true meaning of pain, uneasiness, and suffering.

I began to question Amida's encouragement. Was Amida encouraging me by saying, "Do your best! Don't give up!?" I couldn't feel the slightest encouraged by being told to do my best and not give up. But after thinking about this for a while, I began to see a different point of view. For some reason, it seemed like that was not what was being said about Amida.

What is Amida? Amida is *jishi*, which means [the Buddha of] great compassion. In Sino-Japanese, compassion (*jishi*) is comprised of two characters. The "*ji*", is likened to a friend who is always by my side. "*hi*" means one who feels the same pain and suffering. This is Amida. Amida was always with me, feeling the same pain and suffering as I did. By reciting the name, Namo Amida Butsu, I was reminded that Amida was there, telling me "I am always with you, feeling the same pain you feel, suffering just as much as you are suffering. I will never leave your side. Together, let us live life to its fullest."
